All people supported have their own personalised bedrooms with private en-suite facilities and additional equipment that is identified as being needed; for example, specialist shower chairs, profiling beds etc.

The Role

This role involves providing person-centred support to individuals in managing their daily lives, promoting independence, dignity, and choice. Responsibilities include assisting with personal care, meal preparation, finances, medication, and social activities while enabling people to maintain relationships and develop new skills.

Staff are expected to maintain accurate records, follow company policies, and uphold health and safety, confidentiality, and equality standards. Teamwork, flexibility, and professionalism are essential, along with contributing to the smooth running of the home, engaging individuals in daily tasks, and fostering a positive, inclusive environment where everyone's potential is encouraged and valued.

Support hours are available based on 12-hour shifts from 8am to 8pm or 8pm to 8am, however, there is some flexibility that can be discussed at interview.
