HOURS / WORKING PATTERN

To promote a great work/ life balance, we have a mixture of shifts for our Senior Community Care Workers. We are flexible, but always make sure this suits our clients.

All our team work **alternate weekends**, to make sure our clients are fully supported.

At interview stage we will have a chat about your availability to make sure the role suits you! We will discuss your needs, and build a set rota pattern, so you always know what days you are working.

Typical shift patterns might look like

7am – 2pm (Mornings)

3pm – 10pm (Evenings)

7am – 10pm (Full days)

However these times are flexible, and we can discuss this further at interview stage.

REQUIREMENTS

As your role will involve delivering care to people in their own homes, we are looking for **drivers with their own car**. However, **we will endeavour to make sure you work in your local area**, so you're never far from home!

Applicants must have care experience, and a Level 3 in Adult Social Care (or working towards this)



THE ROLE

As a Senior Community Care Worker, your role will involve senior duties such as;

- Cover the on-call emergency phone (on a rota basis)
- Be the first point of contact for emergencies
- Complete staff spot checks
- Be the first point of contact for Community Care Workers
- Attend weekly management meetings
- Update service user records where required

You will also be supporting with standard Care duties such as;

- Delivering high-quality care services in accordance with individual care plans.
- Assisting clients with personal care tasks, including bathing, dressing, and toileting.
- Supporting clients with medication administration.
- Assisting with mobility and transfers, using appropriate techniques and equipment to ensure safety.
- Providing companionship and emotional support to clients and engage in meaningful conversations and activities.
- Assisting with meal preparation.
- Helping clients maintain their home. This could involve laundry, cleaning, and other domestic tasks.
- Promoting socialisation, taking clients out and about into their community!
