WORKING PATTERNS

Whether you're one of our Care workers or Seniors, our shift times at the same. Whether you're working days, nights, or earlies, your shifts might look like;

Earlies - 7:45am - 2:30pm

Lates - 2:15pm - 9pm

Nights - 8:45pm - 8am

As part of our commitment to resident care during busy peak periods, we ask that once a week, you start and finish slightly earlier. This is to make sure that during busy times (mornings and evenings) that our residents receive the best possible care!

THE ROLES, (AND REQUIREMENTS)

CARE WORKER – (£11 - £11.40 per hour)

As a Care Worker at Hopton Cottage Care Home, you will provide high quality care practices at all times, day and night. Your day to day will involve supporting residents at mealtimes, helping clean resident's kitchenettes and bedrooms, supporting residents on days out and activities, supporting with personal care where needed, and ultimately, making sure our residents are safe, happy and supported.

For our Care Worker roles, we are open to candidates who are both new to care, and have experience.

SENIOR CARE WORKER - (£12 - £12.40 per hour)

In addition to the Care Worker duties, our Seniors also support the day to day running of the service. This could include leading the team, training new starters, administer medication, and act as a general point of contact for the team, including any complex queries or escalations.

For our Senior roles, Candidates must have;

- At least 6 months of Senior Care Worker experience (Essential)
- Level 2, or higher, in Adult Social Care (Desirable)
