THE ROLES

Care Worker (Days & Nights) (£10.50 per hour)

As a Care Worker, you will be the beating heart of our home. You will be providing day to day care for our residents, making sure they have a positive and enriching home. Your day to day might involve;

- Supporting with personal care
- Supporting at mealtimes
- Supporting with medication prompting
- Supporting with activities in and out of the home
- Supporting with socialisation and companionship
- Helping with all aspects of daily care, where needed

Senior Care Worker (Days) (£12 per hour)

As a Senior Care worker we understand how crucial your role is to our Home. Not only driving a team of Care Worker that deliver high quality, personal care to our residents, but also inspiring, developing, and nurturing them to be their best every day.

You'll be motivated, positive and with great interpersonal skills, and you enjoy working in a close-knit team.

Your day to day would involve;

- Day-to-day responsibility for running a unit
- Supporting with issuing medication, review care plans and accurate record keeping
- Driving and managing a team of Care Workers, including responsible for all shift handovers of the teams
- Helping with training and supervision of new staff members so they feel welcomed and supported
- Building relationships with residents, their families and external teams such as GPs and District Nurses
- Assisting residents with a range of personal care duties



HOURS / WORKING PATTERN

We are looking for candidates to work day and night shifts for this vacancy.

Days (Part time) -

Working around 22 hours a week, your shifts would start at 8am, and finish at 8pm.

Nights (Full time) –

Working around 33 hours per week, your shifts would start at 8pm and finish at 8am.

Senior Days (Full time) –

Working around 33 hours per week, your shifts would start at 8am and finish at 8pm.

To make sure our support for the residents is balanced, we do ask that our **Care Workers are available to work alternate weekends.**

Candidates must have a Level 3 in Health and Social Care, or be willing to work towards this - Candidates will need some relevant care experience - Experience at a senior level would be beneficial, but not essential
