### **Support Worker (37.5 hours per week) £12.36 per hour**

**Days** - 8am – 2pm, 2pm – 10pm or 8am – 8pm

**Waking Nights** – 8pm – 8am

A Support Worker provides practical and emotional assistance to adults with learning disabilities and mental health needs, helping them to live as independently as possible. Duties include supporting individuals with daily living tasks, promoting personal choice and dignity, assisting with social and community activities, and encouraging the development of skills and confidence. The role also involves monitoring wellbeing, following care plans, maintaining accurate records, and working collaboratively with families, healthcare professionals, and colleagues to ensure person-centred care and a safe, supportive environment.

### **Senior Support Worker (37.5 hours per week) £13.36 per hour**

**Days** - 8am – 2pm, 2pm – 10pm or 8am – 8pm

A Senior Support Worker provides guidance and leadership within the team, supporting adults with learning disabilities and mental health needs to live fulfilling and independent lives. Alongside delivering direct care and support, the role involves supervising and mentoring staff, overseeing daily operations, and ensuring care plans and support strategies are followed effectively. Responsibilities include promoting high standards of practice, liaising with families and professionals, managing records and reporting, and contributing to the development of services to maintain a safe, person-centred and empowering environment.
