HOURS / WORKING PATTERN

We are looking for a mixture of candidates to join our team, working with either our usual homecare clients, or with those who require End of Life support. Your hours will vary, depending on which role you are interested in;

Care Assistant - £11.75 - £12.03 per hour

We are looking for flexible candidates, who can do a mixture of shifts. These are semi flexible, but all our roles require our team to work alternate weekends. Your might look like;

6am – 2pm (Mornings / Lunches)

3pm – 10.30pm (Evenings / Beds)

We are also open to evenings only, weekends only and bank hours.

End of Life Care Assistant - £11.75 per hour

We also have some hours providing Care to clients that are at the end of their life. These clients require some additional support. To make sure we deliver the best possible care to these clients, the hours of working would be on set days. Your rota would look like;

Mon, Tues, Sat, Sun (Week 1) Wed, Thurs, Fri (Week 2)

You would be **working full days, starting at around 7am, finishing at around 10.30pm**, with a break in the middle of the day, around 2pm. For this role, you will need to be able to travel across Kirklees.

THE ROLE

Care assistants support others to live independently in their own homes, which can include supporting hobbies, activities and day trips, personal care and any other needs of our service users. Your day to day duties might include;

- Delivering high-quality care services in accordance with individual care plans.
- Assisting clients with personal care tasks, including bathing, dressing, and toileting.
- Supporting clients with medication administration.
- Assisting with mobility and transfers, using appropriate techniques and equipment to ensure safety.
- Provide companionship and emotional support to clients and engage in meaningful conversations and activities.
- Assist with meal preparation.
- Help clients maintain their home. This could involve laundry, cleaning, and other domestic tasks.

If you are supporting our clients who require support at the end of the life, you will be required to perform extra duties, however full training will be provided for this.
